## How to Run Your Quiz Night

A quiz night is one of the most profitable and enjoyable fundraising events you can run. With good organisation, a venue of 50-100 people can raise GBP300-GBP600 in a single evening.

### The Basics

- Charge GBP5-GBP10 per person entry (teams of up to 6)
- Add a raffle for extra income (GBP1 per ticket)
- Sell food and drinks throughout the evening
- Include a 'picture round' -- always the most popular
- Keep each round to 10 questions and 10-15 minutes
- Announce scores after each round to build tension

#### HOST SCRIPT -- OPENING

"Good evening everyone and welcome to [Your Name]'s Fundraising Quiz Night! I'm your host for the evening. All proceeds tonight go towards my expedition to [Destination] -- so thank you all so much for being here and supporting me. The rules are simple: no phones, no shouting out answers, and most importantly -- have fun! We have 5 rounds of 10 questions each. Write your team name on your answer sheet and let's get started!"

7. How many bones are in the adult human body? (206)
8. What language is spoken in Brazil? (Portuguese)
9. What is the square root of 144? (12)
10. Who wrote Romeo and Juliet? (William Shakespeare)
